It seems like everywhere we go, we must follow a list of rules, doesn't it? But rules are a structure that keeps us from hurting ourselves or someone else. Bible Club is no exception – rules must be followed for everyone to have a fun-filled, happy, and safe time while we learn about Jesus.

BIBLE CLUB RULES

- All cell phones and electronic games are to be left at home. 1st time will result in your phone or game being held until Bible Club is dismissed. 2nd time your cell phone or game will be delivered to your parents the next day.
- Children will not be allowed to leave the church property until Bible Club is dismissed.
- No use of tobacco products on church property.
- Willful destruction of church property will result in dismissal from the program.
- For safety reasons, everyone will wear shoes at all times unless instructed otherwise for program activities.
- No running indoors.
- Everyone will obey the “18-inches of Space” rule. “18-inches of Space” is your personal perimeter. No one invades your space unless you invite them for a hug or a handshake. You do not invade anyone else’s space either unless you’re invited in for the same reasons. If everyone respects each other’s 18-inches of space, we can avoid hurting or being hurt.
- Everyone will watch for the “One Way” sign. When you see the sign (someone pointing their index finger up), you stop talking IMMEDIATELY and point your index finger upwards too. Pretty soon, everyone’s quiet and ready to listen! Remember: “Faith cometh by hearing...”!
- And finally: Respect other people’s belongings, if it doesn’t belong to you – don’t touch it.

Failure to follow the rules will result in you being removed from your group for a “time-out”. Consistent misbehavior could result in you being excluded from Bible Club.
